

Critical Eye: Movie Reviews



JOKER

Whatever you've heard about this film – ignore it. See it and rate it yourself. Todd Phillips has brilliantly presented a portrait of a complex, tortured character. That the film functions as a prequel to the Batman story almost doesn't matter. What matters is Joaquin Phoenix and his total immersion into the character, a performance nuanced and operatic and

understandable. Academy Award material? Absolutely!

PAIN and GLORY

Pedro Almodovar has teamed with his favorite actors, Antonio Banderas and Penelope Cruz. Together, they've created a memoir filled with fragmented pain and glory presented as if painted on the film . Banderas and Cruz are pitch perfect, but maybe Almodovar should unwind from himself a bit. A big chunk of this looking-backwards, looking-inwards tale gets boring and begins to sag. A cautionary tale to all memoirists — even the best of the best needs an editor.

Library News

Many of OLLI Library's donations are produced by The Teaching Company with lectures by professors from well- known universities. Two are described below.



History is explained in *The Vikings*, with 18 CDs and 36 lectures by Professor Kenneth W. Harl, Professor of Classical and Byzantine History at Tulane University. He explores the Vikings who were not only warriors, but also merchants, artists, kings, raiders, seafarers, shipbuilders, and creators of a remarkable literature of myths and sagas.

Literature is the topic in *The History of the English Language*, 2nd Edition. Professor Seth Lerer, Professor in Humanities, English, and Comparative Literature at Stanford University, explains that centuries ago a wave of settlers from Northern Europe came to the British Isles speaking a mix of Germanic dialects thick with consonants and complex grammatical forms. Today we call that dialect Old English, the ancestor of the language nearly one in five people in the world speaks daily.
