

Class Notices and COVID-19 Update

IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING OLLI CLASSES EFFECTIVE TODAY, MARCH 16 AND THROUGH THE END OF APRIL

As news of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) continues to evolve, OLLI at UCI is doing everything possible to protect the health of and safety of our members, presenters and staff. UCI experts have been communicating often and broadly about how the community can take precautions.

In-person OLLI Classes Suspended Through April Transitioning to Remote Learning beginning March 16.

- 1. As part of this ongoing effort to provide a safe and healthy learning environment, OLLI at UCI will transition all classes to a remote learning experience, starting March 16 and continuing through the end of April.
- 2. This means that the classes will be closed to members except for Presenters, Developers and Facilitators.
- 3. We will record class lectures and OLLI members can access recorded videos via the internet by following the Video Recorded Class Lectures Instructions below. We will post a recording of most classes within 48 hours after the class date.
