Welcome to our new and returning members! Classes will be live streamed via the <u>Remote Learning Center</u>. You can access the Remotle Learning Center by opening your internet browser and typing <u>olli.ce.uci.edu</u>.

New members, you will need to create an account to use the Remote Learning Center. To get started, go to <u>olli.ce.uci.edu</u> and click **Register**. Complete the registration form and enter the unique **Membership ID number which was sent to you in a separate e-mail, along with instructions for setting up your account**, **viewing live streamed classes**, and **accessing the library of recorded classes**. Your Membership ID number starts with the letter 'M'.

Returning members, if you already created an account for the Remote Learning Center, you can use the same log in and password as you used in the Spring and Summer terms. If you are a returning member, but have not yet created an account for the Remote Learning Center, you will need to create an account to watch live streamed classes.
