Individuals who live or work in Orange County, CA can register online through www.Othena.com to view available appointments and to keep informed with upcoming availability.

Othena is a vaccine scheduling system created by CuraPatient, in conjunction with leading health care experts and public health

agencies.

Test kits are available at no cost for individuals who live in Orange County and are asymptomatic or have exposure concerns. **CLICK** to order your test.
