The Current Pandemic (COVID-19)

This class will discuss the most recent epidemiology of the COVID-19 virus. We will discuss the following questions: Is the virus mutating; has our understanding of transmission changed; do masks and social distancing really work; how important are pre-symptomatic and asymptomatic shedding; what is the role of children; is the clinical picture any different; what are our diagnostic tests and how good are they; what do we now understand about treatment; where are we with vaccines; how close are we to controlling this disease?

**Presenter: Thomas Cesario, M.D.**, University of Wisconsin, Madison; Professor of Medicine, Division of Infectious Disease, Professor Emeritus, Department of Medicine, UCI; Former Dean, UCI College of Health Sciences and School of Medicine. Dr. Cesario is a World renowned expert on multiple infectious diseases.

## SC 204 GIANT MAGELLAN TELESCOPE MIRRORS

Attendees may join the Zoom session 10 minutes early and chat among one another.

This talk presents the design, construction and operation of the two 8.4-meter borosilicate honeycomb primary mirrors for the Large Binocular Telescope. We will follow the process from: designing the honeycomb structure, casting the honeycomb mirror substrates, transporting them to the top of Mt. Graham, installing them in the telescope, applying the aluminum coating, and using the mirrors for science observations. We will also follow the history of the entire Large Binocular Telescope project in parallel to the primary mirror development. The discussion will include some of the many parameters to be optimized when designing and building a large ground-based telescope.
