This class will explore the art and lives of Jacob Lawrence, Faith Ringgold and Betye Saar, three black artists who are now recognized for their impact on American Art history. This course will begin with an overview of the Harlem Renaissance and will also introduce the Black Arts Movement.

SC 214 Class Format B LIVING WELL: THE AGING EYE Thursday, Dec. 9 10:00am - 12:00pm

Our presenter will touch on vision loss in the elderly, considered a major health care problem. Approximately one person in three has some form of vision-reducing eye disease by the age of 65. The most common causes of vision loss among the elderly are age-related macular degeneration (AMD), glaucoma, cataract, and diabetic retinopathy. Early detection and treatment of these disorders can assist with reduced vision loss or blindness.

Presenter: Olivia Lee, M.D., Associate Professor, Department of Ophthalmology, and Director, Anterior Segment Imaging Laboratory, Department of Ophthalmology, UCI School of Medicine.
