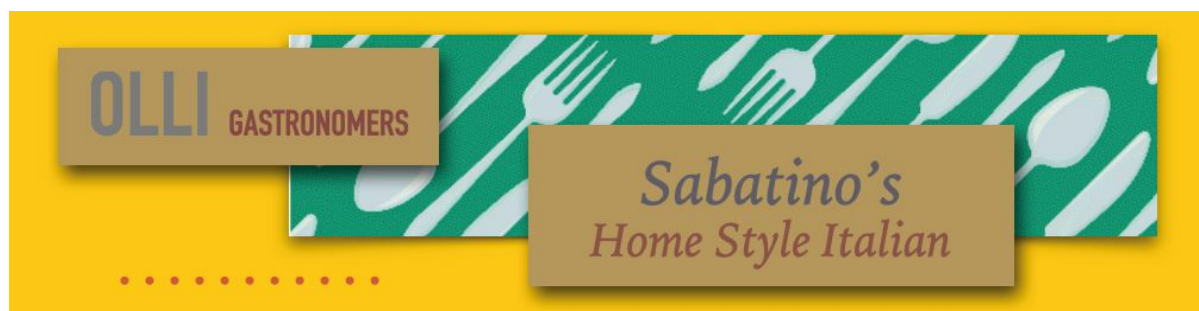

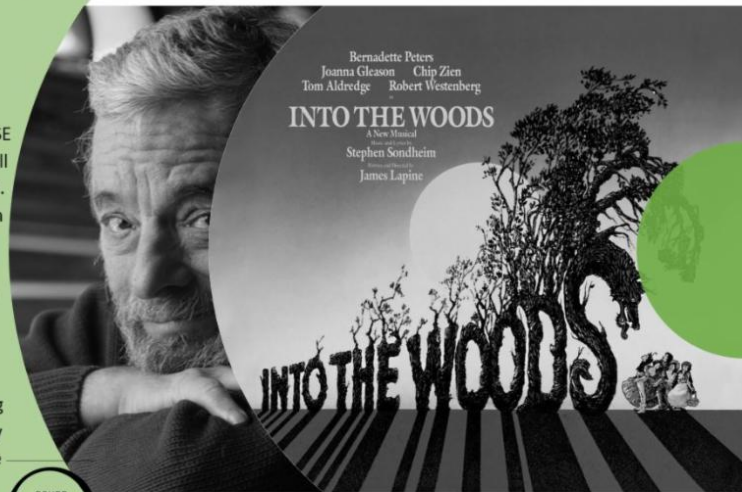
THE LEGACY OF STEPHEN SONDHEIM

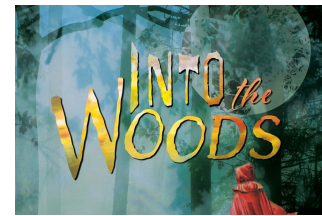

Comprehensive Geriatric Assessment is a multidisciplinary, multidimensional process aimed at detecting medical, psychosocial, and functional issues of older adults that are not identified by traditional performance status measures alone.

Presenter: Katayoun "Katy" Khalighi, M.D., is an Assistant Professor in the Division of Geriatric Medicine & Gerontology, Department of Family Medicine, UCI School of Medicine.

Presenter/ Developer: Steve Weinstein, B.A. in English with a minor in music, University of Pittsburgh.

Sometimes musical compositions are so significant that other composers quote them in their own works or write variations on them. Such is the case with the Requiem Mass sequence Dies Irae (Day of Wrath) and Caprice #24 for solo violin by Niccolò Paganini. Versions have shown up in dozens of pieces over hundreds of years and will probably continue to do so as long as composers find inspiration in them. This course examines how the Dies Irae and Caprice #24 have transcended their beginnings to become launching pads for the exploration of new ideas.

- Caprice No. 24 transcribed for other instruments

- Caprice No. 24 in classical music, jazz, pop, rock, dance and figure skating
- Rachmaninoff's Rhapsody on a Theme of Paganini
