## **Dream Big with OLLI at UCI!**

Approved as a federal holiday in 1983, the "fight to make the Martin Luther King Jr. birthday a holiday took 32 years, a lot of campaigning, and guest appearances including Stevie Wonder, Ted Kennedy, and the National Football League" (NCC, 2021). King's official birthday is on January 15, 1929, but the federal holiday is observed on the third Monday in January as an honor to his legacy of promoting changes in Black Civil Rights through the use of nonviolence.



At UCI, MLK Day provides an opportunity to share the initiatives the University began "in the wake of the racial justice reckoning in 2020," as its purpose "to make UCI the nation's foremost destination for Black people to thrive" (Vice Chancellor Douglas Haynes, Ph.D.). At OLLI, presenter and professional speechwriter, Craig Reem, shared King's, "*I Have A Dream*" speech last month in his "Great Speeches of the 19th and 20th Century" lectures.
