Instructor: Dr. Edgar Moran, Professor of Medicine, Emeritus, UCI Several "Why's" will be discussed in a new course, aimed at an audience interested in searching and acquiring answers.

We plan on answering some "why's" in the following areas of our lives:

- Why's in biology and medicine
- Why's in our economy life
- Why's on political current events
- Why's in the World.

The intention of this course is to inquire into the causes of issues of major interest and find answers to the question "Why?"

I wish to develop our understanding, and to acquire further interest through discussions and study. If necessary, I will provide some of the necessary illustration and documentation.

In this "limited edition" book discussion group, we'll consider three works of historical fiction set in and around London in different eras. Members should read the books in advance of the meetings; all titles are available on Amazon in paperback and as e-books.

attend regularly and write two-page story every two weeks.

Current Issues is a discussion group where we explore timely topics with multiple perspectives and ideas. A committee of members chose the topics and presents issues on a rotating basis, giving background in an impartial manner.

Our first hour will be on Parental Rights in Education presented by Mike Schlesinger. With significant recent controversies about COVID-19, Gender and Critical Race Theory, parents and politicians are becoming more involved in wanting to influence what kids are being taught. Mike will present the legal issues where some states, Congress and the Supreme Court have become involved as well as local Boards of Education and libraries. He will also discuss rights as presented by California Parent Teachers Association (PTA). This should be a lively topic for discussion!

The second hour will be "Potpourri" where we have no presentation, just suggested topics for discussion. Here are the topics:

- 1. Should we continue supporting Ukraine?
- 2. What should US policy on Immigration be when Title 42 (which allows deportation for health reasons like Covid) is discontinued?
- 3. Why are more people leaving California than coming here?
- 4. How do you feel about the Supreme Court decision allowing businesses to refuse service for religious reasons?
