
### THE EFFECTS OF SCIENCE ON SOCIETY





### **DAWN SPACE MISSION:**

Unlocking the Secrets of Solar System Formation

SC 213 Friday, June 9

NASA's Dawn Mission has explored the two largest bodies in the asteroid belt, orbiting Vesta in 2011 and Ceres in 2015-2018. It sent back spectacular images, revealing organic materials delivered by impacts from the outer Solar System on both bodies and discovering a briny sub-surface ocean on Ceres. Dawn has illuminated the effect of location in the proto-solar nebula on the composition and formation of planetary bodies and is profoundly changing our understanding of the genesis of our Solar System.



### THE GETTY CENTER






ADVENTURES IN ECMO:
Pediatric ECMO
Program at CHOC

Monday, May 9 1:30 PM - 3:30 PM ECMO became newsworthy with the COVID-19 pandemic. Extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) is a life support system designed around a sophisticated pump and artificial membrane lung. It is deployed when ventilator support alone is no longer viable in cases of respiratory insufficiency. The bypass system is attached to the patient's blood stream by catheters as in hemodialysis, but the membrane lung allows continuous support for days and weeks if necessary.
