Please note that **the OLLI office is closed today, Monday, June 19th in observance of the Juneteenth holiday**. A little about our newest national holiday from Rodrigo Lazo, Interim Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, University of California, Irvine:

"Juneteenth, an annual commemoration of the end of slavery in the United States after the Civil War. The date that makes up the name of the holiday, June nineteenth, refers to the arrival in Galveston, Texas in 1865 of a Union general who informed the local enslaved population that the war had ended, and they had been freed. Although President Lincoln had signed the Emancipation Proclamation on Jan. 1, 1863, enslaved people in some parts of the United States were not informed of the changes until the end of the war. Since the late nineteenth century, African American groups have organized community celebrations and family gatherings on Juneteenth, and in 2021, the U.S. Congress and President made it a national holiday.

"Juneteenth provides an opportunity for us to reflect on the history of the United States and the role that slavery played in shaping ongoing attitudes about racial difference. After the Civil War, in some parts of the country, true freedom for Blacks remained elusive as a result of discriminatory laws, segregation, and continued denial of rights that have had a lasting effect."

**Hearing Loss and Aging**

Hearing loss is the third most common physical ailment in the United States, trailing only arthritis and heart disease. Approximately, 15-20% of adults have some form of hearing loss, and by age 65, one out of three people have a hearing loss. We will discuss the various types of hearing loss, the impact of hearing loss on neurocognitive health and safety, and various ways to correct hearing loss.

**Presenter:** Dr. Harrison Lin, Associate Professor Otolaryngology. Board-certified otolaryngologist and fellowship-trained in otology, neurotology, and skull base surgery. Dr. Lin graduated with honors from Harvard University and received his medical degree from the University of Southern California.

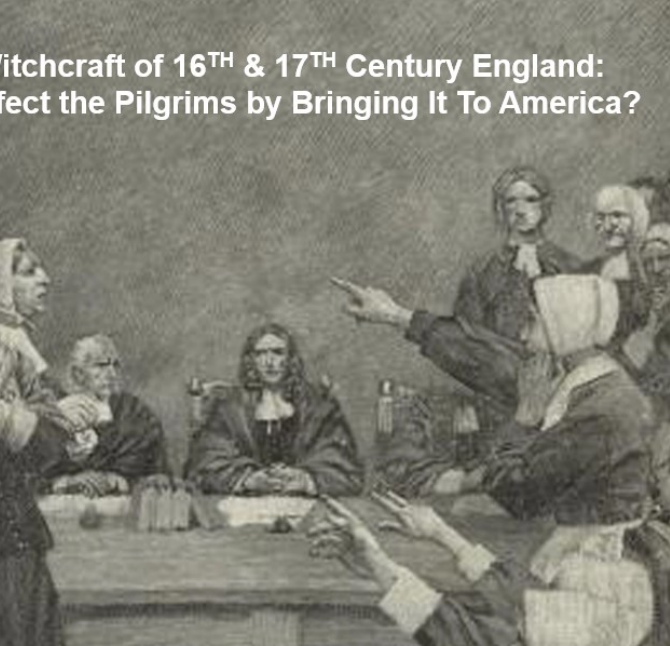

It is argued to have established witch trials during the religious conflict between Protestants and Catholics.

The hysteria did not end in Europe, did the pilgrims bring witch-hysteria to America?
