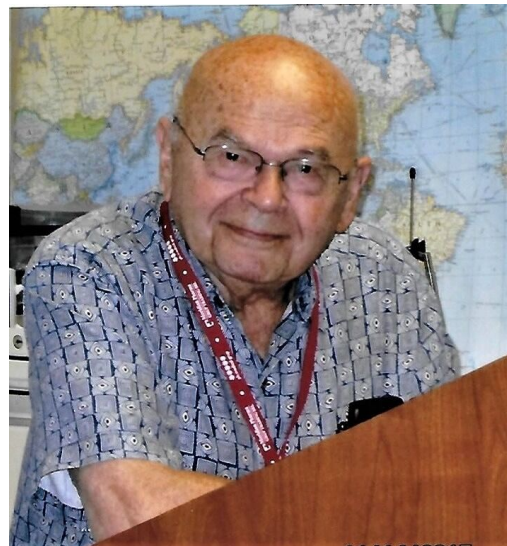



The book described witchcraft and prescribed witch extermination methods, including burning at the stake. It is argued to have established witch trials during the religious conflict between Protestants and Catholics. The hysteria did not end in Europe, did the pilgrims bring witch-hysteria to America?

Presenter: Helen Brooke, MBA, a 2022 graduate of the University of Durham has a Masters in Medieval to Post-Medieval Archaeology, specializing in the English Civil War and Iconoclasm in Cathedrals (1642-1651). She will present from her classroom in the UK.

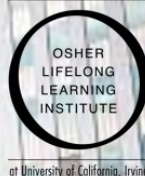

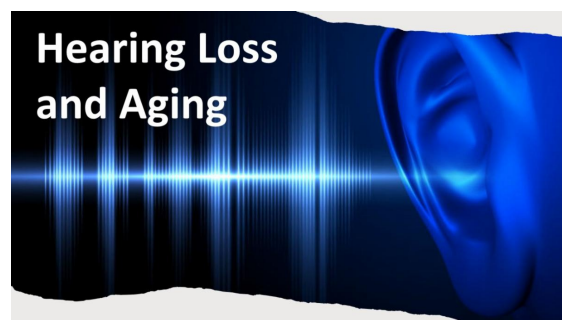

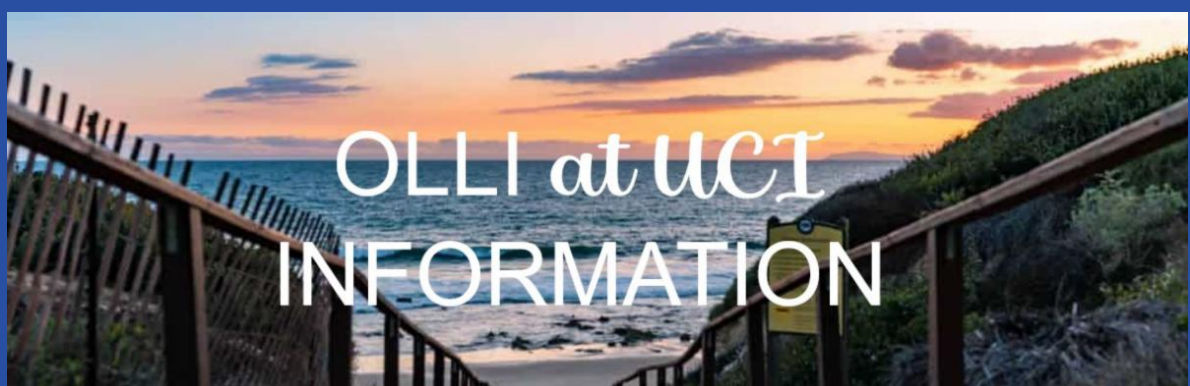
